Career Opportunities with HomeCare & Hospice

Professional:

Registered Nurse (RN)

Requires current NYS RN license and recent nursing experience. Provides all skilled nursing needs, as well as health assessment, evaluation and teaching.

Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)

Requires current NYS LPN license and recent nursing experience. Provides most skilled functions under supervision of RN.

Paraprofessional:

Home Health Aide (HHA)

New York State HHA certification requires 75 hours of training. This training is provided by HomeCare & Hospice. Equivalency testing is available for qualified HHAs and CNAs. Provides health-related tasks and personal care.

Personal Care Aide (PCA)

PCA certification requires 40 hours of training, which is provided by HomeCare & Hospice. Equivalency testing is available for qualified PCAs. Tasks include assistance with personal hygiene, dressing, feeding, walking, meal preparation, light housekeeping and laundry.
